### 1. Looking Back, Expressing Thankfulness (Psalm 126:1-3)

- The psalmist describes God's restoration as "like a dream." What is something in your life that felt too good to be true because of God's faithfulness?
- How does reflecting on God's past faithfulness strengthen your trust in Him for the future?

### 2. Looking Forward, Asking for Help (Psalm 126:4)

- The Israelites prayed for "streams in the Negev" - a sudden and powerful move of God.
- What area of your life or church do you need to ask God to restore or refresh?
- How can we balance gratitude for what God has done with the faith to ask for more?

### 3. Sowing in Tears, Reaping in Joy (Psalm 126:5-6)

- The psalm says, "Those who sow in tears shall reap with shouts of joy." How have you seen perseverance through hardship lead to spiritual growth or fruitfulness?
- What is something difficult you are sowing in right now? How can the group encourage and pray for you as you wait on God's timing?

### Closing Reflection:

- Where have you seen God work in your life or in our church that deserves a response of thankfulness and joy?
- How can you take a step of faith this week to trust God with both your gratitude and your future needs?
