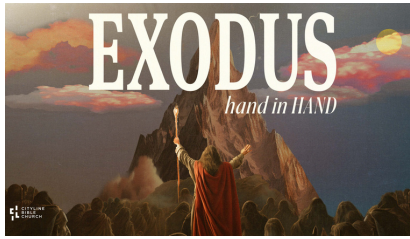


THE SONG OF MOSES - A SONG OF VICTORY



Exodus 15:1-21

Sermon Outline:

1. Praise (vs. 1-3)
2. Testify (vs. 4-8)
3. Trust (vs. 9-10)
4. Confidence (vs. 11-16)
5. Hope (vs. 17-21)

This week we see how the Israelites don't rush past how they were just saved at the Red Sea but instead pause to reflect and praise God. What a great reminder to us too in our busyness to also be intention about giving God the glory - great things He hath done!

Icebreaker:

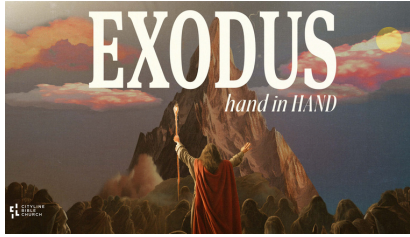
What is the most memorable celebration that you can remember in your life? Why was it so memorable?

Application:

1. PRAISE - Read Exodus 15:1-3, what does worship mean to you? How do you incorporate personal worship into your time with God? (Consider listening to KLove radio or making time in your day to offer praise to God - it doesn't have to include music even).
2. Do you feel you know what it really means to worship God with your whole heart, mind, strength and soul? Or do you hold back praise?
3. TESTIFY - Your testimony can be used by God to help others worship the Lord or even turn to him for the first time. When was the last time you testified about what the Lord has done in your life to others? This is a simple act of faith and doesn't require you be an evangelist - just someone who wants to honor God and tell others of what he has done in your life. No one can argue with your testimony.

4. Read verses 9-10, can you relate to this right now in your life? Do you feel you are being pursued, attacked, overwhelmed? How? Share and ask for prayer.

5. TRUST - But God declares a victory over us as we trust in Him! It might not be the victory that we imagined or the timing we choose, but God will be glorified. (Think of the Israelites, they definitely would not have chosen to cross the Red Sea if it were up to them!) Is that enough for you?

6. CONFIDENCE - Read verses 11-16, because God is who He is, we can have confidence. Split up into groups of 2-3 people and find verses that describe who God is - which then leads us to have confidence in Him. Once you've found at least a verse each, come back together to share and encourage each other by reading God's Word over each other.

7. HOPE was the last theme from the sermon. What is your hope in today? Is it in something you are creating / protecting / directing? Or is that hope in what the Lord is doing, growing and pruning in you? Remember, He who promised is faithful (see Hebrews 10:23).

End your time with a time of worship and prayer - ascribing greatness to God, telling Him with confidence that our hope is in Him alone!
