Sermon Outline

1. Time is limited - God has determined it (Job 14:5, Ps 90:12)
2. Time to be wise - make the best use of it (Eph 5:15-16)
3. Time for God's work - While you still have it (John 9:4)

Questions

1. Time is Limited - God has determined it: In his wisdom, God has set limits around our lives in various ways. While society tells us to resist these limits, we can only flourish within them.

- How does knowing that God has already determined the number of your days affect the way you live today?
- What are some practical ways you can start living more intentionally with the time you've been given?

2. Time to be Wise - Make the Best Use of it: God has given us all the time we need to fulfill the calling he's placed on our lives. It takes intentionality to use it for his glory, because other things will overtake it if we let them.

- What are some common time-wasters that keep you from living wisely? What would it take to cut them out or redeem them?
- How can you include God in the ordinary parts of your day, like commuting, eating, or working, so that all your time is used for His glory?

3. Time for God's Work - While you Still Have it: The world in its present state will not last forever, and our own lives are only a short span. Jesus wants the works of God to be done while there is still time.

- Who is someone in your life God may be prompting you to reach out to, serve, or share your faith with before "the night comes?"
- What step can you take this week to invest your time in God's kingdom - through serving, encouraging, or being present where He's placed you?
