



1. No Compromise in Affection – You Are Holy and Chosen

God's affection for His people is unwavering—even when they don't deserve it. He calls His people holy, set apart, and beautiful. The enemy cannot curse what God has blessed, but we can forget who we are.

Discussion Questions:

- How is my identity shaped more by the world than by God's declaration over me?
- Am I living like someone chosen and called holy by God?

2. No Compromise in Allegiance – Endure Through Temptation

Israel didn't fall by force, but by seduction. Temptation often comes quietly and incrementally. Holiness requires loyalty—allegiance to the God who has claimed us.

Discussion Questions:

- What boundaries have I ignored, thinking it's no big deal?
- What lies or excuses am I believing that make sin look harmless?

3. No Compromise in Accountability – Bring Sin to the Light

Sin thrives in secrecy but dies in the light. God calls His people to expose sin—not to shame them, but to heal them and restore them to wholeness.

Discussion Questions:

- Who in my life can help me walk in the light and keep me accountable?
- How has keeping sin in the dark affected my relationship with God and others?

4. No Compromise in Action – Be Zealous for God

Phinehas didn't wait for someone else to act—he stepped up and honored God with holy zeal. Holiness requires urgency, boldness, and courage.

Discussion Questions:

- Where is God calling me to take bold action for His name?
- What does holy zeal look like in my life right now?
