Ice Breaker:

Did you do anything fun for Halloween? Do you have a favorite Halloween costume that you've worn or seen?

This week, we focused on four movements of prayer to guide our time together:

1. Reverence
2. Response
3. Request
4. Readiness

In reverence, we praise God for who he is (Isa 40:9, 12, 22, 26).

- What do these verses highlight about the nature and character of God? How does this challenge worldly assumptions on who God is?

We then respond with confession and seek to get right with God (Ps 32:5, Rom 12:1).

- Why is it proper to respond in this way in light of who God is?
- Do you struggle to respond to God in this way? How can you overcome this?

After this, we offer our requests to God, seeking to pray especially for our nation during this election season, as well as the witness of our church (1 Tim 2:1, 2 Chron 7:14-15).

- Why does God invite our requests? What does this say about who God is?
- How might our requests not be pleasing to God? What is the proper way to make requests to God? Are some requests more or less proper than others?

Finally, we put on a posture of readiness to fulfill God's calling on us as a church in this important season (Matt 5:13-16).

- What does readiness look like for you in this season?
- What does it look like for CityLine as a church?
