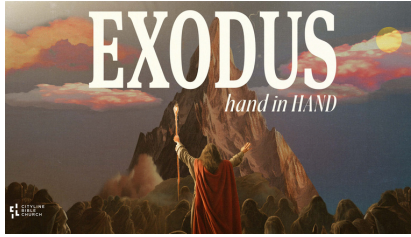


DETERMINED TO DELIVER

Sermon Outline:

1. Israel can't hear because of a broken spirit (v. 9)
2. Moses can't speak because he fears man (v. 10-12)
3. Moses and Aaron can't lose because God has a plan (v. 13-30)
4. Pharaoh can't see because his heart is hard (7:1-13)

Icebreaker:

Recalling the story of the world's fastest mile runner - if you could set the world record for something, what would it be and why?

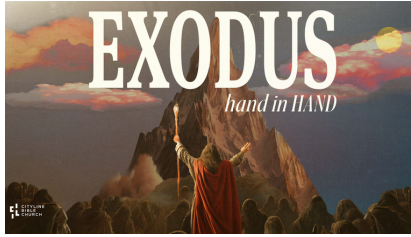
Application:

1. The Israelites couldn't hear because they had a broken spirit. Can you relate to this in any way? Have you had a time in your life where your spirit was broken and you just were not hearing anything from God, please around you or the circumstances? Share.
2. Do you ever fall for this lie - that "If God is in this, it should get easier... If God wanted me to accomplish this, it would go smoothly, without any problems." Why do we, like the Israelites think like this? How do you avoid this?
3. How do you balance having expectations of things and just trusting the Lord? Be it in your marriage, work, family, etc. Do you ever find yourself tempted to just not have any expectations any more just so you won't be hurt or disappointed with an unmet expectation? Why is that dangerous?
4. Have you, like Moses, experienced the fear of man? Where people are big and God turns small? What was that situation? How did you handle it?
5. The sermon shared a few things to over come the fear of man - which one resonates with you?
